### **GNSW Waiver & Release (the release)**

In consideration of being permitted to participate in activities organised by the NSWGFL and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, I, release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the NSWGFL, its officers, members, affiliates and/or directors (collectively the "released parties") from any and all claims, demands, losses, liabilities, damages and/or costs of any nature whatsoever that I, my personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and/or any person or entity claiming through me or on my behalf, may now or hereafter be entitled to assert including, but not limited to, any death, injury, loss of enjoyment or other harm or loss of any nature whatsoever caused or contributed to by, or arising directly or indirectly out of, or in connection with, my participation in activities organised by the NSWGFL.

I agree to indemnify each of the released parties from any and all claims, demands, losses, liabilities, damages and/or costs of any nature whatsoever the released parties may incur due to my actions or inactions as a participant in activities organised by the NSWGFL. This Release is given for and in consideration of the opportunity to participate in the activities organised by the NSWGFL, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged.

The undersigned warrants that he suffers from no minor or serious physical injury; illness or disability that would make him especially susceptible to injury or disability in performing any activity contemplated by this Release. The undersigned also warrants that he is physically able to fully participate in the aforementioned activities and that he fully comprehends and accepts all of the risks associated with such participation.

### **Player and Coaches Code of Conduct**

- \* Play by the rules.
- \* Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain or coach approach the official during a break or after the competition.
- \* Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent will not be tolerated.
- \* Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit, so will you.
- \* Show good sportsmanship. Applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- \* Treat all your fellow participants as you would like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- \* Cooperate with your coach, team-mates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- \* Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please peers, family and coaches.
- \* Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- \* Bring game into disrepute.
- \* Deliberately seeking to injure an opponent.

Any players or coaches who get sent off in a game will automatically be suspended for a minimum of one game.

The accumulation of two unsportsmanlike conducts by a player or coach during a match will result in an automatic send off.

All players and coaches have the right of appeal to the Judiciary.
